The Clinical Therapist is expected to abide by all safety rules and regulations of the facility they support. SPECIFIC DUTIES:

- Conduct initial evaluation and assess client's presenting problems and formulate diagnosis

- Carry out case management services related to client's treatment
- Maintain an active caseload, providing individual, group, family therapy.
- Provide therapies within area of expertise and limits of credentials
- Participate in continuing education activities, remaining knowledgeable in area(s) of expertise
- Attend clinical meetings as appropriate and meet regularly with supervisor to exchange pertinent information and receive supervision
- Maintain client charts and program records in accordance with applicable standards and regulations
- Facilitate groups for clients Maintain a high level of ethical conduct regarding confidentiality, dual-relationships and professional stature

- Provide compliance for third-party payers including making insurance reviews, Chart review, completing prior request.
- Must be a team player, energetic, and a multi-tasked individual with a focus on excellent customer service.

JOB REQUIREMENTS:

Must hold a Master's Degree in Marriage and Family Therapy, Psychology, or Master in Social Work from an accredited school. Experience with a Biblical Counseling, Master in Divinity or Master in Theology perspective preferred. Experience in Motivational Interviewing/Enhancement, Cognitive behavioral therapies, trauma treatment, play therapy and family therapy, Multidimensional Family Therapy, Behavioral Family therapy is preferred but not required. The Licensed Clinical Therapist must have an active license to practice mental health counseling/psychology in the state of New Jersey, or be eligible for licensure. Acceptable licenses include but are not limited to: LPC, LMFT, LCSW, PhD. Minimum 3 years of experience in field.
